Summer Workshops 2014

Three half day workshops for local children and their families - an opportunity to explore the Stonebridge Reserve in creative ways, to notice the richness and diversity of habitats, plant and animal life and share in an enjoyable and educational experience.

Dates and Times

1. Sunday 17th August: Stonebridge Sketchbooks. Making our own visual journals out of a variety of paper and card, before going on a walk around the reserve, stopping at 3 different sites to pay attention to our senses, and record what we notice. Using drawing, writing, rubbings, collections etc.

10.00 am to 12.00 noon 6 - 10 year olds

1.00 pm to 3.00 pm 10 - 14 year olds

2. Friday 29th August: Stonebridge Sculptures. Creating small-scale sculptures from willow withies and other natural/recycled materials, inspired by a guided walk around the reserve and the wildlife that we encounter along the way.

9.30 am to 12.00 noon up to 15 year olds
